Council agreed that before the next Insurance renewal date Clerk should contact One Voice Wales to check insurance requirements for a community council of our size and then obtain quotes from different insurance companies.

It was agreed that this year's supply of the Christmas Event Hog Roast paid for by the Community Council would be a one off. Council discussed the possibility of having a Chairman's Charity Box for people attending this year's Christmas Event to make a donation and agreed to do this.

Cllr. Roberts informed Council that Torfaen CBC had come back with a proposal for the Gateway Site at the junction of Barnfield with Caerleon Road. It would involve a 9ft x 4ft raised bed with a plaque. Torfaen CBC would apply for planning permission and build, plant

and maintain it. For this agreement there will be an annual charge to Ponthir Community Council of £2,500.00. The Community Council would have to pay this charge for the first year but after that local business could be offered the chance to pay for sponsoring this site. Council agreed that Cllr. Roberts should continue to proceed with this project and to make enquiries to see if additional maintenance e.g. village benches could be included in any contract.

It was agreed that in the next edition of the newsletter the Council will detail the major projects that the Council has been considering and will also be asking residents for any further suggestions. The following edition of the newsletter will then detail all suggestions and enable residents to vote on their preferred venture. (Action: Clerk to look into obtaining Insurance Quotes. Cllr. Davies to cost voting flyers. Clerk to confirm number of properties in our community area. Number of properties per newsletter delivery routes to be calculated. Information for articles to be researched by the following: Cllr. Matthews – Christmas Lights, Cllr. Bold – Foodie Project, Clerk – Llanfrechfa Noticeboard, Cllr. Davies – War Memorial, Cllr. Bailey – Play Area. Clerk to confirm whether the TCBC Youth Programme is to continue next year and, if so, whether Community Council's will be asked to match fund this project.)
